class teacher, Principal or the Chair of the Board of Management, so they can be dealt with fairly, appropriately and effectively for all concerned. Follow the school's 'Complaints Procedure' if you wish to make a complaint.

- The use of physical aggression towards another adult or child.
- Approaching someone else's child in order to discuss or chastise them because of the actions of this child towards their own child. (Such an approach to a child may be seen to be an assault on that child and may have legal consequences).
- Smoking and consumption of alcohol or other drugs whilst on school property.
- Dogs being brought on to the school premises.

Should **any** of the above behaviour occur on school premises the school may feel it is necessary to contact the appropriate authorities and if necessary, even ban the offending adult from entering the school grounds. We trust that parents and carers will assist our school with the implementation of this policy and we thank you for your continuing support of the school.

Review

The school community of St Louise de Marillac Primary School has an agreed systematic cycle of review of policies whereby new policies are reviewed after one year and subsequently every three years.

In line with the above, this policy will be reviewed in the academic year 2024/25 and subsequently every three years, unless changes are required by legislation or other needs arise before then. Appendices may be amended as deemed necessary.
